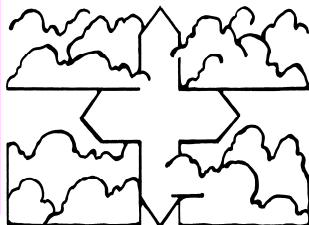

Dear Parishioners,

The man that is moved to action is a man moved by God. These are the words that should inspire and motivate us, especially the men of our Community as we are going to form and establish our own Knights of Columbus Council in the Parish. The Knights of Columbus is a service organization of over 1.6 million members. Each are men of character and distinction who strive on behalf of their faith as well as their conscience. Let us welcome John Brandon as he is going to conduct the drive to get leaders and members at all of the masses this weekend.

On Thursday, April 11, I am going to visit, anoint with the oil for the sick and spend some time with our home bound parishioners. Let us continue to pray for their perseverance, faith and courage as they encounter and experience the Lord's presence in their pains, sufferings, and loneliness. Let us praise Jesus, the Healer and Divine Physician as He touches them with His caring hands and compassionate heart.

To compare, one of the nicest things about the Easter season is that it has escaped much of the commercialization of Christmas. For most, the urge to shop is not part of this great feast. When you think and hear of Easter music, hymns and alleluias come to mind; there are only a few Easter songs. Is there something about this feast so sacred that even the merchandisers have refrained from exploiting it?

At the same time, today's Gospel reminds us that while we do not get caught up with gift-giving, Easter is still a season to remember the gifts unique to it, the Risen Lord brought when He appeared to the Apostles hiding in the upper room behind locked doors. The crippling fear they suffered was released by these gifts.

First of all, he gives them PEACE, which stands for all God's blessings that can enrich human life. Then He breathes the Holy Spirit on them—the great gift of the Risen Lord, allowing them to offer God's forgiveness to all who seek it. And finally, there is the gift of FAITH, the ability to believe without seeing, to read the signs God so generously scatters throughout our world. All these gifts are manifestations of the Spirit.

May the Risen Lord continue to come to us when we lock ourselves away from the world out of fear. Risen Jesus, breathe upon us and send your Spirit to give us the courage to go forth and bring your gifts to others. We praise and thank you for the wonderful gifts of the Easter season. Amen.
