#### Dear Parishioners,

As the year 2013 comes to its finality, I, your Pastor, wishes to express my sincere thanks and appreciation to all the ministries of the parish. Your full support, giving and sharing your talents, skills, special effort and precious time means a lot for the betterment of the community. Thank you so very much. Also, to all parishioners who in one way or another has participated, contributed or has been involved in any way, my gratitude goes to all of you. May God continue to look after you and yours. This Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. I still remember my parishioner back home, that whenever something alarming happened, or something that took her by surprise, she would exclaim in clear and ringing tones, "Jesus, Mary, and Joseph." She was not being irreligious, nor did she takes the Lord's name in vain. Rather, she had been taught from her early years, as a child to invoke the name of the Holy Family whenever she was in trouble or needed help. She took this advice to heart so well that it became her signature, and everybody who knew and loved her knew that, in her world, the invocation of the Holy Family was never far from her lips. In the past, it had been a wonderful prayer, taught to people to invoke the persons of the Holy Family as a preparation for a happy death. "Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I give you my heart and my soul. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, assist me in my last agony. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, may I breathe forth my soul in peace with you." This tradition came from the understanding that Joseph had passed from the world with Jesus and Mary at his side.

Here today at this very moment, the Sunday after Christmas, the Church puts before us the image of the Holy Family and speaks to us about virtue. Indeed, about many virtues, all those positive forces are needed if people are going to be able to live with one another peaceably and in harmony.

Some people have nothing but happiness to relate when they think of their family. Others have nothing but sorrow and frustration to speak of. The family, in our experience, can be a place of joy, or nightmare. In this sense, the family is like the world itself, a place in need of love and redemption. Jesus said that he did not come to condemn the world but to save it. If our experience of family life is good, then give thanks to God for it. Where people's experience of family life is bad, then let us save people from the ruins. Let us pray for our families.

January 1 is a Holy day of obligation and we are honoring Mary as the Holy Mother of God. As we have put it in the Bulletin, we have the Mass at 4:30 P.M. in the Church on December 31 and also on January 1 in the Church at 9 A.M. Please take note that this feast, like the Immaculate Conception, is as much about Jesus as it is about Mary. In affirming that Mary is "Mother of God," we affirm not only her special role in God's plan of salvation, but also the mystery that lies at the heart of the Christmas Season: that in Jesus Christ God truly shares our human condition that God is with us in human experiences of birth and death, joy and sorrow. It is but appropriate that we celebrate this mystery as we start a new calendar year.

**Parish Registration** ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

<u>Young adults</u> ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, should register with the Parish under their own name.

<u>Weddings</u> ... Please call the Parish Office one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).

**Baptisms** ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

**Sponsorship** ... In order to be a sponsor/ godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
