Dear Parishioners,

It is great to reflect on the second reading of this Sunday's Liturgy as this is a wonderful reminder to all of us as a faith community. Paul brings out our unity in diversity. We are responsible for one another as well as for our parish. Each one of us should do his/her part of the task and job that has been entrusted to us as well as possible and so contribute to the well-being of all. We are encouraged to apply this to our Christian lifestyle as we live with our fellow Christians. Don't try to go it alone. Such an approach never works. As is true to members in the family and for religious community life, we need our mutual inspiration. This involves giving and taking. To apply this to our different ministries and committees is commendable. We can call upon a diversity of talents. Honestly, we can ask; In what field are you proficient? The priest/pastor is your preacher/teacher, but you may be particularly adept in the area of finances, building management, showing hospitality, caring for the sick and the homebound, extraordinary minister of communion, reader of the word in the Eucharistic celebration and many more. Just as the body is made up of so many different parts so each one of us is an important part of the body of Christ, the CHURCH.

We all know that when the human body is working well, without aches and pains, we feel fine. We also know that the smallest ache or discomfort can undermine that feeling of well-being. We have all noticed how something as small and seemingly insignificant as an ingrown toenail or a small burn can cause much distress and pain. So it is with the body of Christ, the Church, the Parish, the seemingly smallest thing can cause this body, too, much distress. St. Paul in the second reading from his Letter to the Corinthians, reminds us if one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it, just as if one part is honored, all share in its joy. What St. Paul is telling us is that the pains and trials, concerns and brokenness of one within the Church is the pain and brokenness of all the Church.

The reflection on the Gospel this Sunday is worth noticing too. For it reminds us that while it seems to speak to us about worldly needs, its real emphasis is on spiritual needs. While we are called to feed the poor, we must also allow each person the dignity and the resources to feed themselves. True liberty means more than just political rights; it is a recognition of all human dignity and potential. Recovery of true sight is the ability to be able to envision a world built on Gospel and Spiritual values and to work for that vision and not be satisfied with mere political correctness. The question we may truly ask ourselves is: What have I done to further this vision?

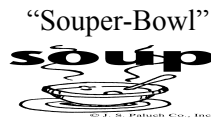

Parish Policies

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
