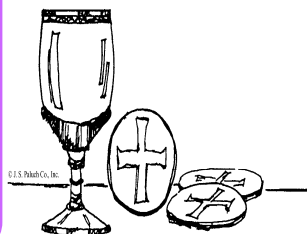
ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT



The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

[A]s often as you eat this bread
and drink the cup,
you proclaim the death of the Lord
until he comes.

— 1 Corinthians 11:26



Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity Of The Most HOLY BODY And BLOOD Of CHRIST. A Feast that encapsulates so many of our beliefs as Catholics. The Church directs us to focus primarily on two of those beliefs: The Real Presence of the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, and the Church as the Body of Christ continuing his work on earth.

Now, the Real Presence is something that has always been a challenging teaching. Because Jesus has told them they must eat his body and drink his blood, some early disciples of Jesus abandoned the course. In fact, it repulsed some of them and seemed impossible to others. But Jesus is God, and nothing is impossible for God. So, Jesus took bread and wine and changed them into his Body and Blood. The celebration of every Mass repeats this miracle through the words and actions of the priest at the Consecration.

Historically and realistically, this Passover is fulfilled in the life of Jesus and his institution of the Eucharist. Eating Christ's body recalls the first Passover, when the Jews slaughtered the unblemished lambs and used their blood to mark the doorposts. The blood was the sign of faithfulness and protected them from the Angel of Death. The lamb was to be roasted and eaten as part of the Passover ritual. Today and forever, Jesus is our Paschal Lamb. His body was given and his blood was shed to redeem us. But, we, too must eat the Lamb. Sure enough, this Sunday's second reading reminds us of this as we hear the words of Jesus said at the Last Supper: This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me. This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. Jesus offered himself for us, serving not only as the sacrifice, but also the high priest. Also in today's gospel, we heard how Jesus used bread to feed the five thousand people.

We have to keep in mind, that each time we receive Holy Communion, we are given the opportunity to attest to our belief that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. Our AMEN in response to being given the host and the wine, says, YES, I believe this is the Body of Christ and Yes, I believe this is the Blood of Christ. Our Catechism tells us that we are unified with the divine action of salvation through the Eucharist. "All who eat the one broken bread, Christ, enter into communion with him and form but one body in him."

Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, this Sunday's solemnity is also about us, as the body of Christ. Let us honor the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let us give special thanks to God for the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, under the appearance of bread and wine. Let us show our thankfulness and gratitude by living today, and each day, in imitation of Jesus, loving one another, sharing our gifts and talents with them the blessing of being part of Christ's body. May God bless us all, Father Angelito

Parish Policies

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
