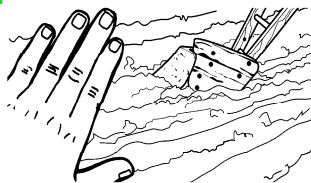

Dear Parishioners,  
Summer season is in full swing. Living by the Jersey Shore is a great blessing for we are close to the water. We are all invited to take this wonderful opportunity to gather together and have some fun with friends and family members. Just a little reminder that we also have to celebrate together and prayer together at home and most especially our Sunday Liturgy on weekends.

The 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time is an appropriate time because God calls each of us to holiness. From our own experience it is not always easy being a Christian. Sometimes or maybe most of the time our beliefs are not very popular with the rest of society. We would think perhaps that it is better to stay and relax at home or go to a ball game, rather than to go to church. It may be more fashionable to dress in the latest trend than to dress modestly. It may feel better to buy that more expensive home than to provide and give something to the poor, the homeless, and the less fortunate. It may seem more polite to stay silent than to defend our faith, or it may be easier to vote the party line than to stand up for catholic ideals.

As our readings for this Sunday, we encounter people who have to make choices. At God's direction, the prophet Elijah chooses Elisha as his successor. But first Elisha provides for his family and then follows the Prophet. Paul urges the Community of Galatia to reflect on the Gospel message as a truer path to salvation. For they must think beyond the Mosaic Law and suppress their own desires of the flesh; instead, they are to live according to the Spirit. As always, Jesus is a model of firm resolve. When his disciples came to a Samaritan village—a place typically not hospitable to Jews, they were not welcomed because Jesus' destination was Jerusalem. The disciples may have wanted revenge but they journeyed on. Like the poor and marginalized with whom he empathized, Jesus had no place to rest his head; and he journeyed on. And where was he going? He was going to Jerusalem to meet his Passion and death. He was going to fulfill the will of his Father. Nothing deterred him.

We, too, are on a journey toward heaven. Each day we will encounter valid responsibilities with family and work, with pleasure and societal pressures. At our Baptism, we were each called to live lives of holiness as followers of Christ. This takes a new way of thinking, a new way of listening, and a new way of living. It requires knowledge of the Gospel; it requires participation in a community of like-minded believers; and it requires God's grace. God has provided for all our needs. Hence, let us continue on our journey.

May God bless us all.

**Parish Registration** ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email [frontoffice@sienachurch.org](mailto:frontoffice@sienachurch.org).

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

**Young adults** ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

**Weddings** ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

**Baptisms** ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

**Sponsorship** ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
