

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, at the ten o'clock Mass, the congregation is going to witness the RCIA Rite of welcoming for John Sims and Tyler Boyden and Call to Continuing Conversion. This rite welcomes baptized, but previously uncatechized adults who are seeking to complete their Christian Initiation through the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist and to be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. I invite you to pray for our RCIA candidates that they may have the strength and courage as they receive God's grace and be admitted to the Sacrament of Confirmation.

We remember today St. Patrick who had a legendary life. He was born a Christian in Britain, either in Scotland or Wales. And at age 16, was abducted by Irish raiders, who removed him to Ireland. Perhaps he was forced to work as a shepherd, in the process not only nurturing a desire to escape, but discovering a latent spirituality. Having duly fled after six years of slavery in Ireland, he traveled to France , where he was ordained and spent some years on missionary work before Celestine I, who declared a Bishop and sent him to Ireland, perhaps in 432, to gather the Irish into one fold of Christ.

His work in Ireland necessarily brought Patrick into conflict not just with local chiefs and kings, but also with other religious leaders. He claimed once to have been beaten, robbed, and set in chains. He asserted not only that he had baptized thousands of people, but had established numerous chapels and, in particular, convents. He is said to have been buried in the grounds of what is now Down Cathedral in Ulster.

As I have shared in my homily last Sunday, Anthony de Mello said that God in heaven holds every person by a string. Every time the person sins, the string is severed, the person cuts him or herself from God. But when the person goes to confession, string is knotted and once again he re- establishes his relationship with God. The beauty of it, however, is when the string is knotted it gets shorted and the person becomes closer to God. Having said that, on Monday, March 18 at 7:00 in the evening, we are going to have the Lenten Parish Penance Service in the Church. Some priests in the area are going to help us up for confessions and absolutions. Please come and be reconciled, re –establish and renew our commitment to Jesus as a faith-filled people of God. God bless us all,

ABSTINENCE from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.

FASTING is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

Easter Food Blessing

On **Saturday, March 30**, beginning at 9:00 A.M. at the church, there will be morning prayers followed by the blessing of Easter foods. Foods are usually brought to church in some form of basket lined with a white cloth that symbolizes the shroud of Christ. Often, a ribbon or bow is fastened to the basket's handle and some form of greenery is included in the basket. A candle, symbolizing Christ, the Light of the World can also be included. On Easter morning, each member of the family eats a small portion of each of the blessed foods. *Items that can be included for the blessing can include any of the following:*

bread - represents Jesus, the Bread of Life butter - can be molded into the shape of a lamb to symbolize, Jesus, the Lamb of God

salt - for zest, purification

pepper, horseradish, mustard - represent the bitter sacrifice of Christ, the bitter with the sweet in life

ham - for the joy of the Easter season, abundance hard cooked eggs - represent new life, Resurrection kielbasa - for God's generosity towards true believers bacon - for God's mercy

candy - for the sweetness of new life in Christ, eternal life, good things to come

babka (sweet cake) - represents the sweetness of the $${\rm Lord}$$

vinegar - remembers the sour wine offered to Christ on the cross

wine - reminds us of the wedding feast at Cana

Collections

HELPFUL HINTS FROM THE MONEY COUNTING TEAMS:

• Put the dollar amount on the outside of the envelopes to get proper credit.

• Do not put stickers, address labels, staples, or scotch tape on the outside of the envelopes as they will not go through the scanner.

• If you are writing one check for both collections, write the dollar amount you want on each envelope and FOLD the 2nd collection envelope and put inside the 1st collection envelope along with the one check. Do not cut the top off the 2nd collection and include as it cannot be scanned.

• Since all cash goes through a money counting machine, please do not fold or crinkle up loose bills.

Weekly envelopes are scanned and the dollar amount is entered into a computer for yearly totals. Remembering these few items would be a tremendous help and save time and improve the process.

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org).

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

<u>Young adults</u> ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, should register with the Parish under their own name.

<u>Weddings</u> ... Please call the Parish Office one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/ godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
