Dear Parishioners,

Happy and Blessed Easter to all!

What does Easter mean to us? Year after year we have this Solemnity, the Resurrection of the Lord, and yet how do we honor it? What is the message to us of this Great Celebration?

I remember the late John Paul II began his papal ministry in October of 1978, addressing the whole world: "Brothers and sisters, do not be afraid to welcome Christ and accept his power. . . Do not be afraid to welcome Christ and accept his power. . . Do not be afraid. Open wide the doors for Christ. To his saving power open the boundaries of States, economic and political systems, the vast fields of culture, civilization and development. Do not be afraid. Christ knows what is in man. He alone knows it. So often today man does not know what is within him, in the depths of his mind and heart. So often he is uncertain about the meaning of his life on this earth. He is assailed by doubt, a doubt which turns into despair. We ask you therefore, we beg you with humility and trust, let Christ speak to man. He alone has words of life, yes, of eternal life."

The question is: why is it that Blessed John Paul is so critical to be rid of fear? Because, it is fear that prevents us from being about the work of the Lord. The Risen Jesus wants to cast out our fears in order to make room for our faith.

This day of resurrection is not similar to the raising of Jairus' daughter or Lazarus from the dead. It is not just that these two later died again and that Jesus did not, it is far more deeper than that. For the raising of Jairus' daughter and Lazarus led them to return to their normal kind of life and routine. Actually, they became celebrities and had stories to tell. However, it is totally different with Jesus. Jesus was raised and lives forever. And his Death and resurrection call for something new; for they demand a solemn and repeated proclamation: Christ is risen; Christ is indeed risen! The whole world is now different because of this meaningful event.

We cannot proclaim that our universe or our nation or our community or our family is changed unless we are open to faith such that we are changed. That is why Blessed John Paul called upon us to open wide the doors for Christ. Perhaps it has been years for us, we who have celebrated this Easter Feast many times in the past. Perhaps this is our first Easter Celebration. In any case, let us cast aside all our fears; we must open wide the doors of our hearts and souls for Christ. Then we must go and proclaim how he wants to make a difference everywhere.

Today, we congratulate among us our RCIA candidates as they have been sincerely admitted to our flock, the Body of Christ, the Church. To all of us, Jesus says, Do not be afraid. For He has brought us courage, joy, hope, faith and love. Rejoice and be glad because Jesus is risen from the dead. Amen.

Have a wonderful Easter and let us all celebrate for God has fulfilled his promise of the Resurrection!

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
