



Dear Parishioners,

Today is the 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Knowing and relating to God through Jesus, we have nothing to fear.

There is a doctor who called his patient over the phone and told him: "I have some bad news and worse news for you. The bad news is that all your tests show you have 24 hours to live." The patient said, "What could be worse than that?" The doctor replied, "I have been trying to reach you since yesterday."

For some years, there was a brand of clothing that many of the young generation was wearing. It was called No Fear. In our world which is full of danger and violence, the name conveyed an attitude that one could do anything fearlessly. This could be a little bit alarming, but in a world of faith and unity which is centered on Jesus Christ, it can and must be a motto for living.

Fear, of course, is awesome if it motivates us to protect ourselves from some threat to the wellbeing of ourselves or of those we love. Fear motivates and stimulates us emotionally to be ready for fight or flight. And yet, as we know, a lot of people are consumed by fears that are groundless, unreasonable. or certain things we cannot do anything about except to pray.

Looking back at the story of Jesus walking on the water, notice that it is an unusual miracle. Normally, when Jesus worked on a miracle, he was responding to someone else's needs like hunger, sickness, evil spirit possession, storms on the sea. Jesus walking on the water is simply a manifestation of his divine nature. There are a multitude of references in the Old Testament to god walking on the water or the sea. Seeing him approaching them, the Apostles got nervous and panicked and Jesus said: "take courage, it is I, be not afraid." "It is I" is an important part of the gospel because it gives greater clarity about what this event meant. It could mean, "it's just me." But it is also in Greek the name that God gave Moses when Moses wanted to know God's name: "I am," or "I am who I am." Why does Jesus wish to reveal himself in this way? If we are going to look at the three gospels that tell the story of Jesus walking on the water (Matthew, Mark, and Luke), it immediately follows the story of the miraculous feeding and is linked to it. The Eucharistic symbolism that begins with the miracle of the feeding continues into the story of walking on the water. There we have the Apostles struggling in the night with the wind against them, feeling as if they were making no progress. Suddenly Jesus assures them of his presence. He brings courage and calms their fears by announcing his presence, which he will also do for us, and which he especially does in the Eucharist when he tell us: "this is my body," "this is my blood."

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

<u>Weddings</u> ... Please call the Parish Office one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
