"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened. and I will give you rest. Dear Parishioners.

going to be our regular weekend assistant in St. Catherine's. Fr. Al. as he prefers to be called, is a retired priest from the Archdiocese of Newark, New Jersey. For him, as he has been coming and saying the Mass, our parish community is a warm welcoming parish. For more information about Fr. Al, please see page three of this Bulletin. This Sunday's Gospel reading contains one of the most comforting and encouraging invitations Jesus ever issued. However, it is an invitation that is too often overlooked and taken for granted by his too busy and preoccupied followers today. Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give vou rest. Furthermore, our Lord uses an unusual parable to complete the invitation: Take my yoke upon you and you will find rest for yourselves. For my voke is easy, and my burden light. A voke by the way, is a double harness made of wood that is custom-made and placed on the necks of a pair of oxen to enable them to pull a plow together. Jesus was known throughout Galilee as the carpenter's son. The young Jesus learned a few things about woodworking from his foster father Joseph in the shop in Nazareth. A smooth fitting yoke to place on the shoulders of a pair of oxen is something Jesus could probably speak about from experience.

This Sunday let us welcome with gladness and joy the presence of Rev. Father Alfred Burke. He is

Therefore, when Jesus says we should take his yoke upon us and learn from him, he is offering to share our burdens with us the way draft animals support one another by pulling together. And with Jesus helping us, our burden is lighter and the yokes made by him are a perfect fit to make our travel together through life easier.

He has already come to us, through his birth, his teachings and miracles, his death and resurrection and ascension, through grace and the sacraments as well. He has come as far as possible. Coming to him implies we have to move closer, we have more to learn from him. We have to take time to pray, to read and reflect on the Scriptures, to forgive those who have hurt us, to be kind to others and other things we've been taught about living a life of holiness. We should not expect that Jesus is going to make us rich and take all our problems away. He did promise a cross to follow him. However, life is a lot easier when we have Jesus as part of our day to day lives. My voke is easy and my burden light. Come to me all you who labor and are burdened. Amen.

### **Important Parish Information**

<u>Parish Registration</u> ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

**Young adults** ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.** 

<u>Weddings</u> ... Please call the Parish Office one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).

**Baptisms** ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

**Sponsorship** ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
