**The Most Holy Trinity**

God so loved the world  
that he gave his only Son.

— John 3:16a

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to share with you an interesting story about a little boy who had been a Dennis the Menace all day and was saying bedtime prayers with his dad. After a short prayer, the little boy asked his dad to leave him alone so he could talk to God by himself. Dad asked, "what have you done that you don't want me to know about." "If I tell you," the boy said, "you'll get angry and shout and yell, but God will listen, forgive me and forget about it." The parable of the Prodigal Son somewhat resembles that story. Or, as we call it also the parable of the Prodigal Father. Happy Father's Day to all our fathers whether actual fathers or those who play the role of a father in someone's life. I guess we become emotional if our dearest father has already gone ahead of us. However, the best that we can do for them would be to remember them in our prayers and be grateful to God for letting us be created and taken care of by our fathers. Kudos to all our Fathers!

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. Tertullian, one of the Church's Theologians was the first to use the word "TRINITY" to describe God around the year 200 AD. The council of Nicaea, adopted the term 125 years later in formulating the Creed we proclaim each week at Sunday Liturgy. It took a very long time for the fathers and theologians to clarify the doctrine of the Trinity. There were many reasons that it took such a long time.

The primary reasons would be:

1) That belief in one God was so deeply embedded in the Jewish faith, the faith that gave birth to Christianity and (2) because three persons in one God was such an entirely new and difficult concept. As we reflect on one of the basic mysteries of our faith, the Holy Trinity, one of the most important things about a mystery is that we can know some things about it but we cannot understand it fully. That is the way the Trinity has always been and always will be as long as we live in this world. God is too great for our minds to understand. It should not be a mystery for us that God is too great for us to fully understand God if we are on the same level as God is, and we are not. In God's kingdom we will see God as God is and then we will not need to understand for we will be captivated by all that God is and we will be filled with enough awe and love to last us forever.

## Important Parish Information

**Parish Registration ...** To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email [frontoffice@sienachurch.org](mailto:frontoffice@sienachurch.org).

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

**Young adults ...** who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

**Weddings ...** Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

**Baptisms ...** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

**Sponsorship ...** In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
