Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we as faithful people of Jesus Christ's Church celebrate the Solemnity of Saints PETER and PAUL, Apostles of Jesus.

Each country has its national heroes. They are usually the Founding Fathers or heroic leaders in their struggle for freedom, democracy and self-determination. These heroes stand for values their country cherishes. They give the people their solidarity and oneness. That is why children learn about them in school and celebrate their birthdays. Hero worship also entails dangers, especially when heroes are questionable characters. In this day and age, worshipping only sports celebrities or movie stars tells us something about those who worship them. In the heroes, we worship values that they stand or stood for.

In our faith, we have two heroes who have captured the popular imagination of the faithful in the Catholic Roman Tradition for centuries who are founders of the Church in Rome, namely, the Apostles Peter and Paul. Their feast days were celebrated of course first in Rome, and from there, devotion to these great saints spread all over the Church. There were thousands of pilgrimages to their graves that are organized even up to the present age.

Hundreds of churches and parishes have chosen Peter and Paul as their patron saints. Hence celebrating their memorials today, we are reminded of their strong dedication and great heroism and we are challenged to follow their incredible examples of heroic Christianity.

Taking some time to read the lives of these two spiritual giants, we can ask ourselves: what do we learn from them? Perhaps it is the call to courageous perseverance that will speak to us: the call that invites us not just to answer the question that Jesus poses to Peter in today's Gospel---- Who do you say that I am?—but to embrace the answer and to live in the reality that Jesus truly is the Christ, the Son of the living God. Both Paul and Peter answered through the witness of their lives. Both were passionate for Christ, providing an example for us when we are faced with trials and difficulties.

As we enjoy the Season of Summer, let us take this opportunity to be more with God as we encounter Him every single day of our lives.

Important Parish Information

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
