

Dear Parishioners,

Congratulations to Dan Sakowski on his ordination to the Permanent Diaconate of the Diocese of Trenton this coming May 10, at the Cathedral of the Assumption in Trenton. Together with other candidates, Bishop David O'Connell is the ordaining minister and presider at the Mass along with other priests of the Diocese of Trenton. Allow me to give some basic information about Dan. He started in the parish not just an ordinary parishioner who together with his loving family comes to Sunday liturgies. He also started helping with the Religious Education Ministry in 2005 when he took over for his wife's class due to illness. Dan started teaching his daughter Danielle's class and continued teaching for another five years. Upon responding to God's call to be in the diaconate program, he was not able to help anymore in the Religious Education Program.

He has been so involved with the Youth Group Ministry after his oldest daughter, Danielle, was confirmed and currently he is the Youth Minister.

This school year, Dan came back to teach one of the parish's Eighth Grade Confirmation Classes as it was his youngest daughter, Gabrielle's Confirmation.

After completing his four years of spiritual formation and

training, Dan is going to be ordained as a Permanent Deacon in the Diocese of Trenton and doing his ministry in our parish.

We pray for Dan as he responded to God's call to be of service to Him and His people, that he may be an effective spiritual leader to our community. Let us show our oneness and support to him as we welcome Dan to be another Deacon in the parish.

The story which we heard in the Gospel this Third Sunday of Easter is one of the most beautifully written by St. Luke and it offers a wealth of religious insight. The road to Emmaus was only about seven miles long, but what was discovered along that road was invaluable for people of faith. On their journey Jesus explained how his life, death and resurrection were all part of the fulfillment of God's promise of salvation, given to us in different forms throughout history.

If we listen carefully to the Gospel, it is noteworthy to say that Jesus was setting all of us on the right road to everlasting life when he spoke to the two disciples along the road to Emmaus. He was showing to them and to us that God has a plan for our salvation, and that we can know that plan through studying the Sacred Scriptures and by listening to Jesus. God had been telling us about his plan from the time of Abraham and we must admit that we do not understand.

Today, let us listen carefully to what Jesus wants us to learn about God's love and about Jesus showing that love by dying for us all and rising from the dead.

Risen Lord, be present among us as you were present to your disciples at Emmaus, so that you might open our minds to understand your word as you empower us to be witness to your resurrection. Amen.

<u>Parish Registration</u> ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

<u>Weddings</u> ... Please call the Parish Office one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
