

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Dav)

If we have died with Christ. we believe we shall also live with him. Dear Parishioners,

We welcome and are happy to see and have with us our 6th graders in Religious Education at the celebration of the Mass wherein our faith community gathers to pray, worship and offer immense thanksgiving to the Lord Jesus. He continues to be with us in his Word, in his Body and Blood, and in the congregation who praise and give appreciation for the many gifts he bestows on us.

Today the whole Christendom commemorates all the Faithful Departed. Praying for our deceased relatives and friends is what our feast of All Souls is about, for we can find comfort in knowing that "by giving up his own Son for our sins, God's plan for us is one of benevolent love." We learn this from our Catechism, that through Christ's sacrifice, death is not the end. Though not visible, the dead are ever present in our joys and sorrows, and we help them through our prayers. This is what we believe, this is the basis of our faith. In fact, I trust that my Father who passed away more than a year ago looks after me, my Mother and the rest of my family members. He continues to be with me not only in memory but the great things he has shared and taught me when he was still around.

Again, according to what we have learned in Catechism, "Hope is expressed and nurtured in prayer." Although we may feel bad when we do not receive the result we prayed for and suffer loss, that is not a reason to stop praying. We are assured in Sacred Scriptures that our prayers make a big difference for the holy souls. It is through our prayers, the offering of the Eucharist, that the souls are drawn closer to God, and are able to rejoice in the great happiness of a glimpse of God and are granted clemency and relief. This teaching is from Saint Augustine and Saint Catherine of Genoa.

I guess one of the keys in reconciling all our conflicting feelings regarding death is our faith that God and God's love are stronger than death. St. Paul says in the 2nd reading, God will raise the dead in the same way that God created everything from nothing: "with a word of command." It is therefore our faith that God who in the Gospel reading today promises a reward that is greater in heaven is powerful enough to bring that about.

However, even if we have faith, we still mourn and feel so down and sad for those who have died. Maybe this is only normal, since they have passed from our sight and no longer relate to them as we once did. Again, read the Gospel, Jesus did not instruct the mourners to stop mourning immediately, but rather he promised that they shall be comforted. Today we celebrate the fact that we are still united with our deceased loved ones with the embrace of God's love. Amen.

Important Parish Information

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

<u>Weddings</u> ... Please call the Parish Office one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
