Dear Parishioners,

“I have risen: I am with you once more.”

We thank our RCIA team, led by the Coordinator Barbara Ust, for their tireless dedication and excellent guidance as they continue to do an excellent job on this ministry. Kudos to all our invited guest presenters who have prepared and performed very well as they share their knowledge of their faith for the group. Thank you so much. Finally, a big word of thanks to the sponsors of our candidates as well as to the whole parish community for your outstanding support through your sincere prayers and encouraging thoughts. As your Pastor, I am truly grateful.

The Apostles of Jesus were the eyewitness of their Master and friend rising from the dead. Their “good news” of the resurrection spread against all odds, persecution, heresy, sinful leadership and a way of life that demanded unselfishness and self-sacrifice. Their promise was a promise of new life, eternal life, to those who heard the “good news” and believed in it. Their promise was a promise of risen life for those who are born again into Christ’s life. We heard St. Paul proclaim it in today’s 2<sup>nd</sup> reading: “we were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life. St. Paul has equally echoed our epistle for Easter Sunday, “You have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory.”

The Book of Daniel in the Bible tells us: “Many of those whose bodies lie dead and buried will rise up, some to everlasting life and some to shame everlasting contempt.” True enough our bodies will rise again on the last day, but not all will rise to glory. However, it is not our place to decide which group might end up where. We cannot judge anyone’s heart, only God can. It’s our place to know that we are saved, not by our own capability or power, but through our union with the glorified and risen Christ and to find peace in knowing that God’s mercy is offered to all who seek him.’

And so here are some questions for us. What signs of the Risen Jesus and of God’s new creation can I see already in the world? Has my faith in the resurrection of Christ reoriented my values so that I may “seek what is above”? Full of gladness and hope, let us celebrate Easter with inspiring thoughts as we leave the Church today. With a new resolve in mind, let us praise the Lord and rejoice and be glad because this is the day the Lord has made. Today is the day of hope and salvation. Amen.

## Important Parish Information

**Parish Registration** ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email [frontoffice@sienachurch.org](mailto:frontoffice@sienachurch.org).

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

**Young adults** ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

**Weddings** ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

**Baptisms** ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

**Sponsorship** ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
