Dear Parishioners,

The Diocese of Trenton is about to launch an initiative on pastoral planning, we call it, FAITH In Our Future. This planning process is aimed at developing a long term, sustainable plan regarding the maximization of the resources at the Diocesan and parish levels. Allow me to share with you the Goals for the FAITH in Our Future:

- 1) Strengthen and enliven the parishes in the Diocese as well as Diocesan-sponsored organizations and ministries.
- 2) Explore new models of leadership in parishes and ministries in institutional settings (Schools, Colleges, Hospitals, Nursing homes, Prisons, etc.) in order to address the challenges presented by the anticipated retirement of a large number of clergy and religious over the next ten years.
- 3) Improve our stewardship of personnel, finances, and facilities and other parish and Diocesan resources.
- 4) Establish collaborative relationships among the parishes and ministries of the Diocese that will build upon the Gospel to re-evangelize the local church, especially those who live on the fringes of the Church, as well as those who do not yet know Christ.
- 5) Provide for pastoral ministry to Hispanic Catholics, the fastest growing segment of our Diocesan population, within our parishes and organizations.

On the First Sunday of Advent, Bishop O'Connell will publicly announce this diocesan-wide planning initiative. Over the next 18 months or so all 107 parishes as well as all special ministries and institutions of the diocese will participate in the development of a diocesan-wide plan.

In preparation for the launching of "Faith in Our Future," I as a pastor was asked to form a Planning Core Team. We are glad to present to you the Team: Robert Mercado, who is going to lead the team, Richard Schuberth, Cindy Ventura and Robert Ambrose. They are generous enough to represent the parish community.

As you would notice, the team is composed of the Pastor, and four other parish members. Those selected are not to include other clergy or any employee. The one who leads the team is not the pastor, but a lay person. The training will take place on the evening of Tuesday, November 17 at 7-9 PM in St. Mary Parish Spiritual Center, 1 Phalanx Road, Colts Neck, NJ

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of All Saints. When we read the lives of the saints we can find great inspiration but we can also find it so hard to see how we, with all our faults and weaknesses, can ever approach their holiness. I find that the most essential thing in reading the lives of the saints is to focus on Jesus Christ, for the lives of the saints are to be seen in this light. In Jesus Christ we are all invited to share in a mystery of love that goes beyond our understanding and comprehension and imagination. It is by welcoming this mystery into our lives that we are able to follow the example of the saints.

May the love of Our Lord Jesus Christ fill us with a greater measure of his presence, his power and his Holy Spirit on this All Saints' Day. Amen.
