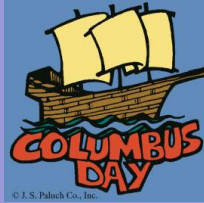

Dear Parishioners,

It is always with sheer joy when we see little children coming to the Church, most especially at Sunday Liturgies. We recognize the time and effort of those dedicated parents taking their young ones to be with us praying, worshipping and thanking God together as one big family. This Sunday we are going to have the Children's Liturgy at the 11:30 Mass. The parish community invites more parents to bring their kids to make use of this wonderful activity.

Today is the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

I would like to bring to your attention and reflect on the second reading this Sunday with Paul's letter to the Philippians as he encourages us to have no anxiety at all. Obviously it sounds good, however it is easier said than done.

As we know there are some synonyms for anxiety which are concern, unease, apprehension and worry. We can consider another one, that is disquiet. You and I would agree that it is hard for us not to be anxious at times. In fact we become anxious about people, about our children, our spouse, our sick or aging parents. Similarly we become anxious about work, mortgages and car payments, etc. Notice that when we become anxious, we disturb the quiet within, and so in effect we become disquiet. What St. Paul implies is that in order to enter into prayer, into a conversation with God, we need to leave behind our anxiousness. This is not an easy thing to do. These distractions of our daily lives often overrun our quiet moments with God. This we must guard against.

Our dialogue with God does not need to be complicated. We have the tendency to overcomplicate things, to excuse ourselves from following through. This is true in different aspects of life. However, prayer does not need to be complicated. As we know we can pray anytime, anywhere.

Here are some suggestions where we can pray. We can be in the shower, praising the Lord for another day. We can reflect on the day ahead with the Lord while we are getting dressed. During our commute to work or while running errands, we can surely invite the Lord into a very difficult encounter we keep having. Before we begin our lunch, we can ask the Lord's blessing on our food and drink and those who gather to share a meal together. Before we fall asleep, we can review the day and express our gratitude and thanks for what went right and beg for forgiveness for what went wrong.

In our solitude and quietness as we encounter the Lord, we will find and know the Lord's peace, and the peace and tranquility will guard our hearts and minds in Jesus.

Therefore let us not grow anxious about too many things. But instead, try to commit to a profound rhythm of prayer every day. Let us learn from St. Paul as he teaches, the God of peace will be with us and we will reap tremendous fruit. Amen.

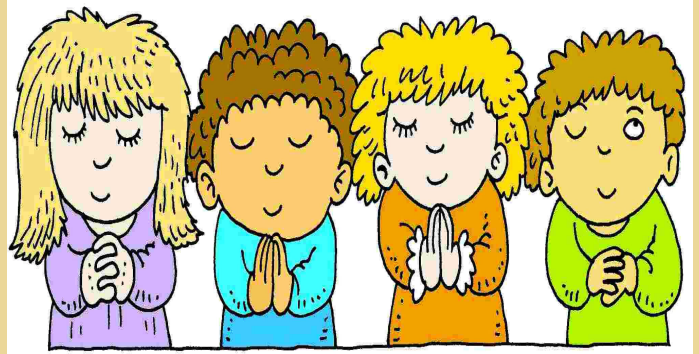

In order to serve you better, we ask that you please take a few moments to register, to be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish. Young Adults ... who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, should register with the Parish under their own name.

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office *one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.)*.

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance. Prior to scheduling the baptism of your child, sponsor letters, donation, and attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents. Godparents/sponsors are also encouraged to attend. Classes are held in Classroom 10 at 7:30 P.M. on the last Monday of each month. To sign up you must fill out the registration form on our website for the date you wish to attend or email deacondan@sienachurch.org.

Recommendation for Sponsorship ... In order to be a godparent/sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all their Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully (*showing attendance through the use of your church envelopes or the welcome envelopes located in the narthex*); be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.
