Welcome Back! - At the first meeting of St.
Catherine of Siena's Rosary Altar Society, held on
September 20th, the calendar of events was
reviewed and adopted for the coming year. The

Please remember that this calendar is somewhat
flexible and there may be some changes in it as the

This year the meetings will begin at 7:15 pm with recitation of the Rosary in the Church, followed by the meeting in the Parish Hall.

October is Rosary Month and members of the Rosary Altar Society are encouraged to recite the Rosary following the 9:00 am daily Mass in the Chapel (Monday – Friday, no Mass on Wednesdays).

At the meeting on Thursday, October 18th

we'll start the ornaments for this year's Giving Tree and discuss the Halloween Bake Sale and the Thanksgiving Food Drive. Maria DeMeno will collect your payment of \$128 if you are going to the play *Once* on Broadway on March 16, 2013.

The Halloween Bake Sale will be held after all of the Masses on the weekend of October 27/28. Please bring your baked goods to the Parish Hall on your way into Mass that weekend and don't forget to help sell the baked goods after Mass.

Food Collections for the Thanksgiving Food

Baskets start the weekend of the 27/28 also. You can help by donating foodstuffs appropriate for Thanksgiving dinner such as a small turkey (12 – 15 lbs.), instant potatoes, stuffing mix, canned or packaged gravy, canned sweet potatoes, canned vegetables, cranberry sauce, cake mixes (or muffin or brownie mixes), canned fruit, hot chocolate mix, cans of coffee, tea bags and juice. If you prefer, you can donate a gift card that can be used to purchase a turkey. You can also help by bringing donations over to the Parish Hall after Mass.

The Covered Dish Supper & Parish

Gathering on Sunday, November 4 from 4:30 – 7:00 pm is an opportunity to meet parishioners you may not know and to joyfully participate in the community of the St. Catherine of Siena family. We hope to see you there. Don't forget to sign up after Mass to bring an appetizer, a main dish, a salad or a dessert and indicate how many people (your family and friends) will attend. If you don't cook, there is a need for things like bread, butter, ice, and beverages. There's also set up and clean up.

In November we will assemble the Thanksgiving Food Baskets and set up the Giving Tree. We hope you can join us for any or all of these fall events.
