How many times has not it been asked, "Why this incredible revelation of the Unity and Trinity of God?" Was the mystery of the God of Israel, so near yet so transcendent, so loving and so terrible, not sufficient to put our minds and hearts in crisis? Wasn't it enough for us to experience the merciful and benign God, slow to anger and rich in mercy, and at the same time witness innocent people suffering and observe the agony of the praying believer in the silence of God, as we note in many psalms and even in the prayer of Jesus on the Cross: "Why have you forsaken me?" And yet, the mystery of the Trinity is the most beneficial

In giving his Son, he has given himself because the Father and the Son are one in perfect communion; they are one in the Spirit. The Holy Spirit is at the origin of the mutual relationship of love between the Father and the Son. The Triune God is the first beginning and the last of the Christian living.

> "Intimate mystery of the Trinity; each person is the perfect transparence of the other. Here Jesus reveals to us that the Spirit enters the inter-play of total transparency. The love relationship between the Three Persons has ... no hiding places, none of the Three keeps anything as 'His own'; everything is shared, communicated, given - and everything is welcomed, received. Our human words are incapable of expressing the ineffable quality of the relationship which makes Father, Son and Spirit One. This is the Source of all our human relationships."

O Divine Trinity, ocean of love, may I be immersed in you. Amen.



Inspiration of the Week

Jesus knew how it would be. He knew we would stumble in the dark, grasping for answers. And so he sent us a light: the Holy Spirit, the Illumination of all that is true.

Dare we look into the light?

Are we ready to see the truth?

Memorare, Explained

The Memorare is a prayer to the Blessed Mother in which the supplicant calls upon the maternal love and protection of Mary's intercession in an hour of dire need. "I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my mother," reads one section of the prayer, which goes on to beseech "the Mother of the Word Incarnate" to receive these petitions with love and mercy.



St. Teresa of Calcutta and St. Francis de Sales were two great devotees of this prayer.

Popularized in the 17th century by a French priest named Fr. Claude Bernard, the text is derived from an older and longer prayer entitled "*Ad sanctitatis tuae pedes, dulcissima Virgo Maria*" ("at your holy feet, most sweet Virgin Mary"). The title "Memorare" is taken from the Latin word for "remember," which begins the prayer.

The modern version appears in the 1846 Raccolta, a collection of indulgenced prayers.

Godparent For the Sacrament of Baptism | Sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation

To Serve as a Godparent

To serve as a godparent is more than an honor—it is a sacred calling. A godparent supports the faith journey of a child by example, prayer, and ongoing spiritual encouragement. Chosen not just for closeness, but for character and commitment to the Catholic faith, a godparent walks alongside the child and their family, helping to nurture a life rooted in Christ.

To Serve as a Confirmation Sponsor

To serve as a Confirmation sponsor is a meaningful role in the life of a young Catholic. A sponsor stands as a witness to the faith, guiding the candidate through prayer, encouragement, and example. Chosen for their active Catholic life, sponsors help the candidate grow in their relationship with Christ and take their place as a fully initiated member of the Church. It is a commitment of presence, prayer, and ongoing spiritual support.

Eligibility

According to Canon Law, godparents & sponsors must:

Be a practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church

Be at least 16 yrs of age

Received the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist, & Confirmation

Not be bound by canonical penalties

Not be the father or mother of the one being baptized

Letter of Good Standing

Before we can issue "a letter of good standing" from the Office of the Pastor, we ask that you be an active, registered parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. An active member:

Attends Mass on a regular basis & is registered, showing regular participation with the life, mission and support of St. Catherine of Siena Parish.

Note, if he/she received all his/her sacraments here at St. Catherine of Siena Parish years ago <u>but now lives elsewhere</u>, <u>he/she is not a member of this parish</u>.

Rather, he/she is a member of the parish in whose territory he/she resides.

This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.


